Degree Description

Public Administration Management is a four-year program in which students are eligible for the degree upon completion of at least 240 academic credits (ECTS):

Basic Education: 60 ECTS

Compulsory Subjects: 132 ECTS

Elective Subjects: 30 ECTS
Work Placement: 12 ECTS
Final Dissertation: 6 ECTS

About our faculty

Since 2007, the campus is located in La Laboral, Ciudad de la Cultura (Gijón). The college has 40 classrooms, 11 seminar rooms fully-equipped with high-tech devices, 6 computer labs for academic purposes and 3 more computer labs with free access. They will advise you on how to have a successful experience once you have been accepted into an internship program. The Business Relations Office offers a wide variety of scholarships which include 'Erasmus-Practicas' scholarship, allowing students to develop their internship abroad.
